In the meantime Jesus is pressing on to Jerusalem, since that will where he will be killed, it being the nature of that city to kill its prophets. Where is the kingdom? It is here, as a seed is in the ground; in due course it will be like the tree. It is both here and yet to come and we live between those two points. Use the time well.

Where are we in God's timetable and what are the consequences of living where we do? What will the rejection of God's kingdom by Israel lead to in God's plans for the world?
